**2023 FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS
APPLICATION**

The North Augusta Cultural Arts Council (NACAC), a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, was founded in 1996 by a group of North Augusta citizens to support artists and art organizations and sponsor projects that enhance the arts in the North Augusta community. Funds come from patrons of the arts through donations collected throughout the year at local cultural events and solicited from businesses and citizens in the area. The *Fine Arts Scholarship* is awarded annually to a graduating senior. Beginning in 2023, this scholarship is jointly funded by the NACAC and the Arts & Heritage Center of North Augusta (AHCNA) which was founded in 2009 with permanent gallery and museum space in the North Augusta Municipal Building. The AHCNA is also a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, funded through memberships, grants and donations in support of regional artists, arts and historical organizations.

In 2019 another art scholarship, the *Max Gazda Endowed Scholarship*, was added and is now awarded annually. To date, using both scholarships, we have awarded thirty recipients with art scholarships for a total of \$27,000.

Scholarship applicants must be attending high school (public, private, charter, or home school) and priority will be given to applicants residing in the Aiken County Area II School District. He/she must demonstrate excellence in an art form. Eligible applicants must intend to enroll in an accredited college, university, or other institution of formal education in the fall of 2023 to pursue a major or minor in one of the art disciplines.

All applications are reviewed by a Scholarship Panel comprised of members of the NACAC Board of Directors. If there is no qualified candidate who resides in the Area II School District, the Scholarship Panel may select a candidate who resides in the greater North Augusta area. Demonstrated artistic talent is the primary criterion for selection.

Application Submittal Deadline: Saturday, March 25, 2023

Please submit the following:

1. Application Information Page found in the application.
2. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher, with both letters being mailed directly to the Scholarship Panel. The second letter should be from an individual with specific knowledge of the applicant's special talents and abilities in his/her art form, and should address the following:
 - Recent accomplishments
 - Demonstrated willingness to work toward improvement
 - Some estimation of potential level of achievement
3. Essay from applicant stating his/her plans for higher education, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship. Include information that would inform the Scholarship Panel about you as an artist.
4. Listing of awards received and activities that applicant participates in, both on and off campus.
5. Current transcript from applicant's high school guidance office.
6. Letter of acceptance from an accredited college, university or other institution of formal training.
7. Work Sample that demonstrates the applicant's abilities.
 - **Music – Instrumental or Voice** – An audio or video file on DVD or flash drive, 3-6 minutes in length. Music selection should reflect technical proficiency as well as interpretive skills. Titles and composers of selections must accompany the audio sample. Original compositions may be included. Applicant must be identified if performing in an ensemble.
 - **Dance** – A video file on DVD or flash drive, 3-6 minutes in length. The choice of choreography should reflect both technical proficiency and interpretive skills. A brief description of the pieces performed must accompany the video sample. Applicant must be identified if dancing in an ensemble.
 - **Theatre** – A video file on DVD or flash drive, 3-6 minutes in length. Other individuals may be in the scene(s), but the applicant's role should be primary. Titles and names of author(s) of selections must accompany the video. Applicant must be identified if performing in ensemble. Original scripts may be included.
 - **Visual Arts** – A portfolio with 3-6 original pieces showcasing the applicant's talent. The portfolio may contain work from more than one medium. Background information, including medium used, date completed, and awards received should accompany the portfolio.
 - **Literary Arts** – Writing sample of fiction, poetry, or nonfiction, not to exceed 20 pages. Single-spaced for poems, double-spaced for fiction or nonfiction. Also, one-act or full-length plays may be submitted. The work must be original. The manuscripts must be typed. Label the manuscript with your name and list the title(s) and completion date(s) of the piece(s) submitted.
